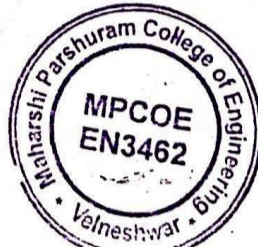

Topics covered are as follows

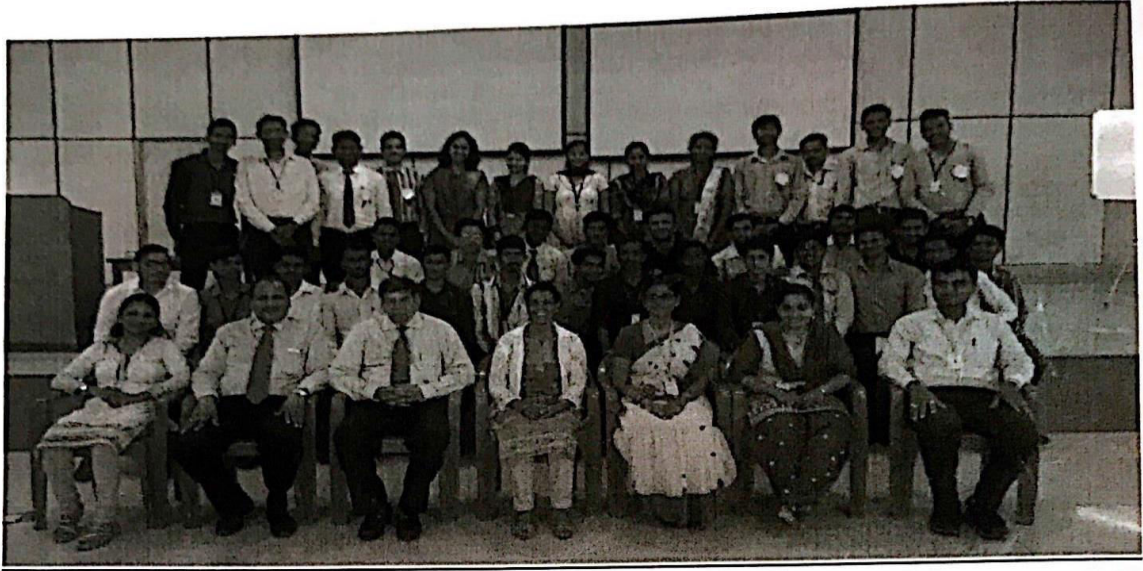

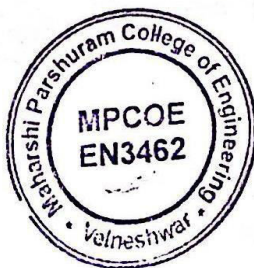
