## Report on Guest lecture series by Mr. Anil Londhe

Mr. Anil Londhe is the eminent personality from the Geotechnical Engineering field and Marine construction. He has more than 40m years of experience in his field. He is the member of council of senior scientist. He visits MPCOE once in semester to interact with the student of SE,TE and BE.

## **Objective of this program:**

1. To aware the students regarding practical applications of Geotechnical field.

2. To encourage the students to do the internship or hands on training program and its necessity.

3. To analyze the project ideas of final year students during first phase of project.

Mr. Londhe visited to civil engineering department of MPCOE during 25<sup>th</sup> July 2019 to 27<sup>th</sup> July 2019. On first day he did interaction with faculty members and discussed various topics and recent trends in civil engineering. Next day he delivered seminar on Introduction to 'Geo-technical Engineering Part-I and II, with some practical examples' for third year students. In Geo-technical Engineering he also covered topics like Soil mechanics, Core samples of rock, Ground improvement techniques etc. He shared his valuable knowledge and field's experiences with students, so the student should get an idea about typical problem occurs on field.

On same day in afternoon session he interacted with students 'Necessity of internship /on field training during the under graduate program'. For this session he asked those students who had recently done internship in summer vacation at various places to share their experiences of internship, and later he explained do's and don'ts during internship or while choosing internship area/site. He said internship gives you experience, your interest of area and subject where you can do better performance in

future. In this session Second year civil engineering students also participated with third year civil engineering students.

On third day Mr. Londhe reviewed ideas of BE projects.. He gave some important suggestions to improve the quality of project and presentation skill of students. Also suggest some project which will be helpful in student's future. For this review total 14 group of BE student of (academic year 2019-20) gave presentation.
