Report of Site Visit to “Polavaram Project, Bora Caves, TU 142 Aircraft”

The civil department has arranged an Industrial Visit for T.E and B.E Civil from 3rd April 2018 to 9th April 2018. Mr. Anvesh Sarade has explained regarding project details. Overall 60 Students accompanied with 4 faculties has participated during visit.

Polavaram is the small village which is located in West Godavari District, Andhra Pradesh. The purpose of the dam is Irrigation, Power and Transportation purpose. Type of dam is Concrete Spillway with height 754m, Non overflow masonry dam 560m, and Earth Dam 160m.

Here the students studied about general information of dam, spillway, reservoir, drainage gallery, different stages of power station and tourism of Polavaram.

During the visit, they visited Bora caves. The purpose of visit to Borra Caves is for the subject Engineering Geology. The Borra Caves, also called Borra Guhalu (Borra means hole in Odia language and guhalu means caves in Telugu language), are located on the East Coast of India, in the Ananthagiri hills of the Araku Valley (with hill ranges' elevation varying from 800 to 1,300 m [2,600 to 4,300 ft]) of the Visakhapatnam district in Andhra Pradesh.
